



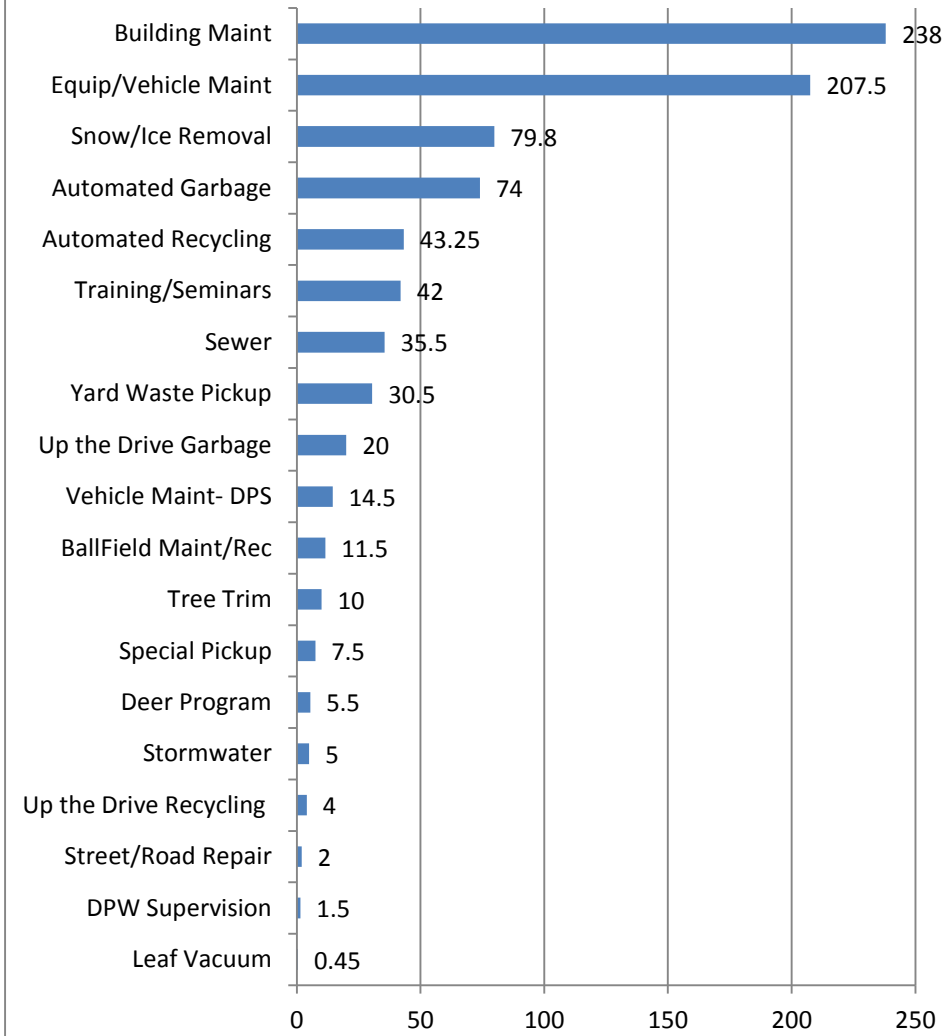
## Highlights

- Completed a review of the new DCUS building operations including presentations by the electrician, plumber, fire sprinkler installer, and HVAC installer on how our building operates.
- Rebecca and sewer technicians met with vendors who are providing quotes on monitoring our sewer lift stations.
- Inspections continued for the new DCUS Building. We are expecting to receive full occupancy within the next week. Crews have received permission to move items into the building.
- Crews completed holiday tree and wreath collection.
- Recycling tons are starting out strong this year with 53.95 tons collected in January and 42.78 tons collected last year by this time. Garbage tons are down so far this year with 75.39 tons collected in January and 92.39 tons collected last year.
- Crews completed 3 special pick-ups in January.
- Crews had three snow removal events in January. We spent almost 80 hours on snow removal in January. All equipment is now functioning correctly after some breakdowns in the December storm.
- Crews completed the monthly January sewer lift station maintenance.
- The yard waste that was collected roadside this year was ground into a mulch product that will be sold to residents later this year. The leaves that were collected were hauled out by Leisner's soil at no cost to the Village.
