



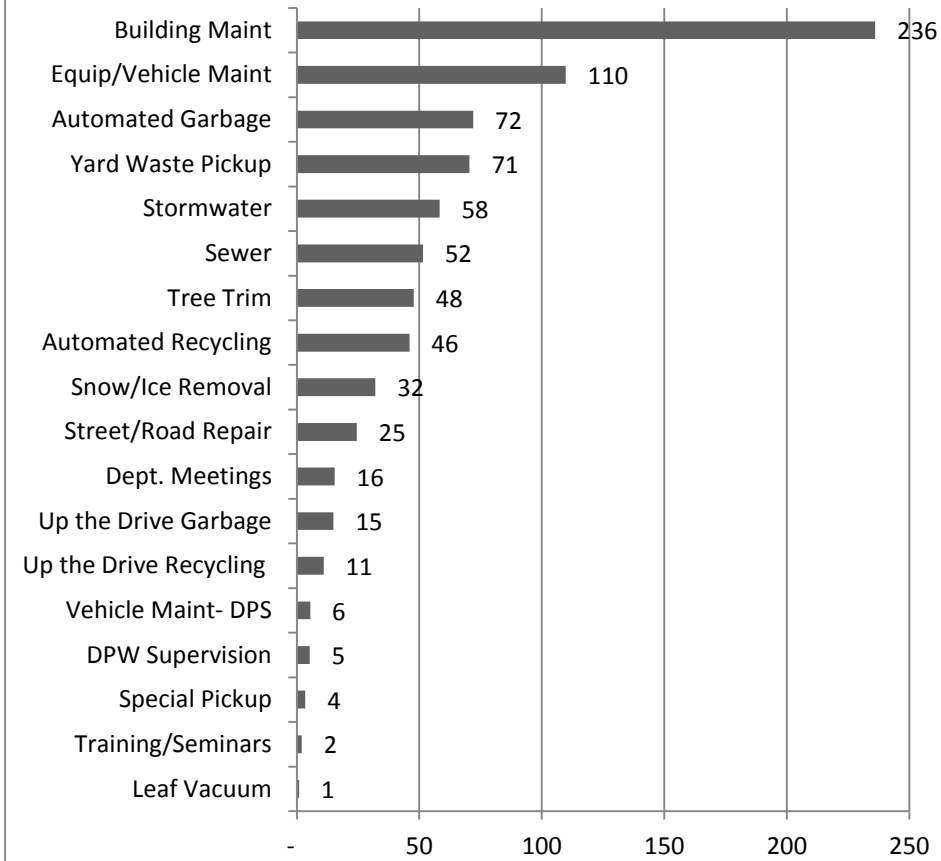
## Highlights

- Crews put up the tennis court nets and cleaned the inside of the pavilion.
- Crews began to remove some snow equipment and removed the sled hill fence.
- Crews completed the seasonal monthly inspection of the Ellsworth Park Playground equipment and cleaned the grounds around the playground and pavilion .
- Crews completed monthly sanitary sewer lift station maintenance.
- Collectively crews spent 17.5 hours on snow operations on March 1 and 8 hours on March 24.
- Crews completed mailbox repair on mailboxes that were damaged during past snow storms.
- Crews completed an early yard waste collection week due to previous storm damage and nice weather.
- Crews reviewed the culverts in the 2016 road project area to determine which ones will need repairs as part of the road project.
- Crews reviewed the manholes in the 2016 road project area to determine what repairs are needed.
- Crews completed the quarterly sewer meter readings at the Bayside businesses.
- Crews completed an inventory of signs in the Village that need to be replaced or straightened.
- Over 150 trees were ordered for the Village's spring tree planting program.

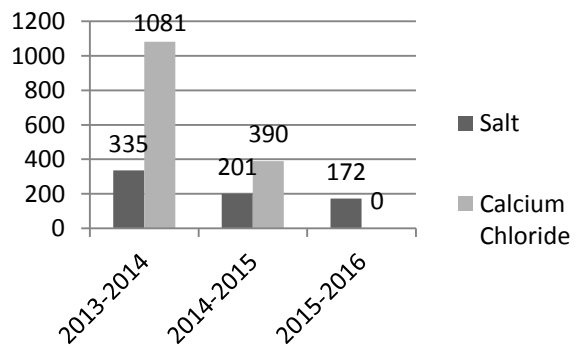
## Top Priorities for April:
