



## Community and Utility Services Monthly Report April 2016

### Highlights

- Crews began work on the driveway culvert replacement program. Crews cut all the driveways of homes that are part of the project. Crews will continue to remove the driveway approaches and start replacing culverts through May and June.
- Crews removed 11 trees that needed to be removed due to death or safety concerns. KEI planted 186 new trees in the Village through the public and private tree replacement program. This planting was done with funds from the Urban Forestry Grant.
- Crews set up, cleaned up and participated in the April 23 Clean Up Day event.
- Crews worked on filling potholes and correcting damaged shoulder from the winter.
- Crews completed 2 full yard waste collections and one new bagged item only collection week. Crews have had all collections done on schedule.
- Crews completed 21 special pick-ups so far this year and 23 mulch deliveries. Together these two services have generated \$3,549 in revenue.
- Crews helped set up and take down for the April election.
- Crews replaced the Ellsworth park well pump that serves the pavilion as it would not start up this Spring. The pump was from 1985.
- Crews held a drop off night form yard waste, recycling and electronics. 35 cars came through the event.
- Crews were out salting on Saturday, April 9 for 2.5 hours in the last snow event of the season.
- A public meeting was held to discuss the 2016 road project and culvert replacement program.
- Rebecca submitted the MMSD Chapter 13 stormwater report.
- There were 6 projects before the Architectural Review Committee in April.

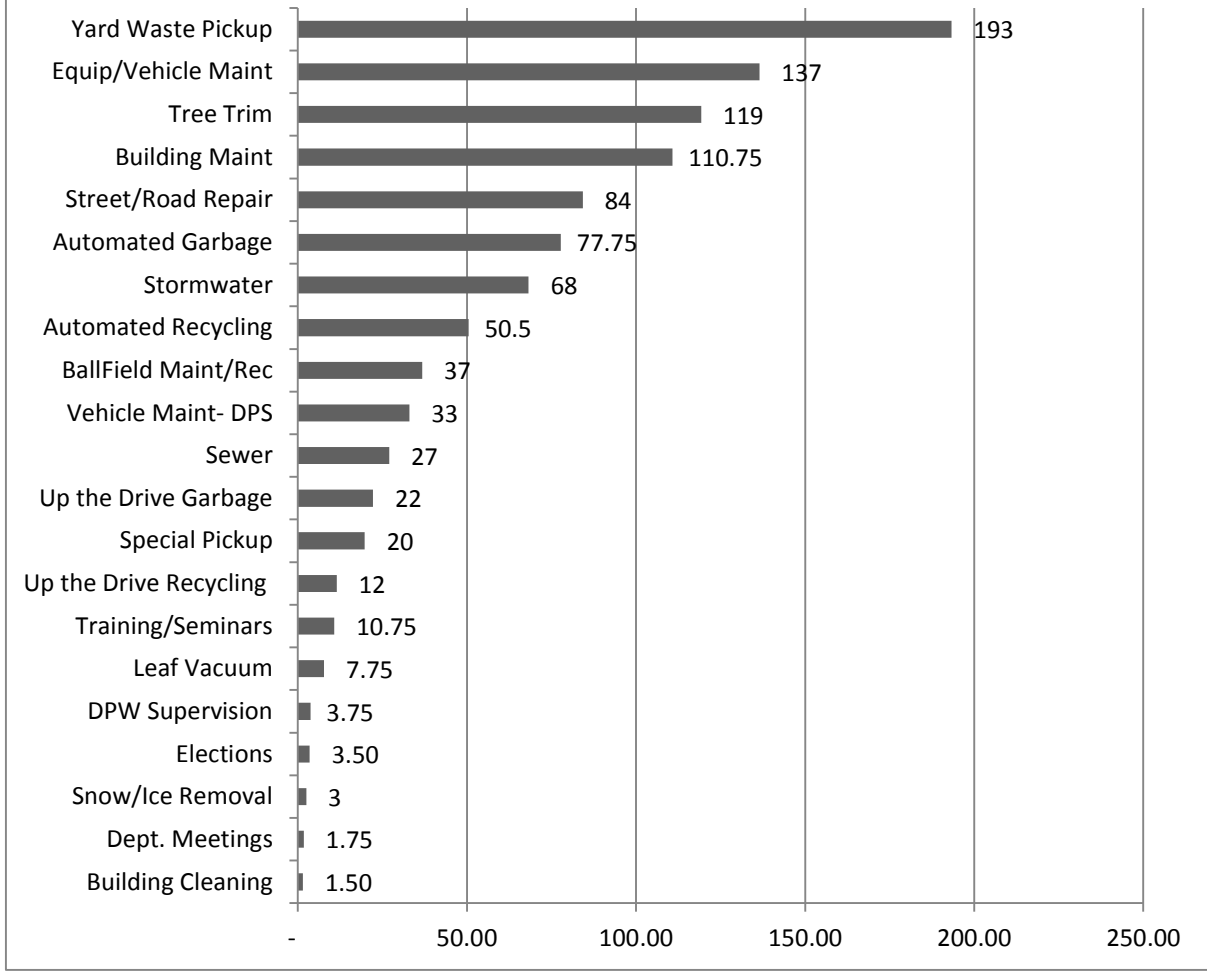
