

Community and Utility Services Report: June, 2017

Highlights/Accomplishments:

- Crews continued the driveway culvert replacement program by removing aprons on Seneca, Greenvale, and Fielding, and began new culvert installation and ditching on Seneca.
- 112 cars participated in the June Saturday Drop-Off Day.
- KEI completed plantings at Village entryway signs, planter beds on Brown Deer Road, the Broadmoor island, Brown Deer Road/Lake Drive, and Village Hall.
- Crews cleared brush and debris at the corner of Navajo and Brown Deer, at the Tennyson-Hermitage park, from a cross culvert for Fish Creek on Wakefield Court, and from the west end of Wahner to allow stormwater to flow to Indian Creek.
- Crews detailed the park and picked-up yard waste along the parade route for the 4th of July activities.
- Monthly lift station maintenance was completed.
