

Community and Utility Services Report: July, 2017

Highlights/Accomplishments:

- Crews have completed installing new driveway culverts, ditching, and landscape restoration on North Seneca Road. New culverts and ditching has been finished on the 8800 block of North Greenvale Road and Greenvale Court. Manhole rehabilitation was completed in the 2017 road project area.
- 103 cars participated in the July Saturday Drop-Off Day.
- Crews removed weeds from the terrace area and refreshed with traffic bond.
- The Village Hall painting and roofing projects were completed.
- Crews installed rip rap in the Grudemont neighborhood as well as around the MMSD lift station to aid in stormwater management.
- Monthly lift station maintenance was completed.
