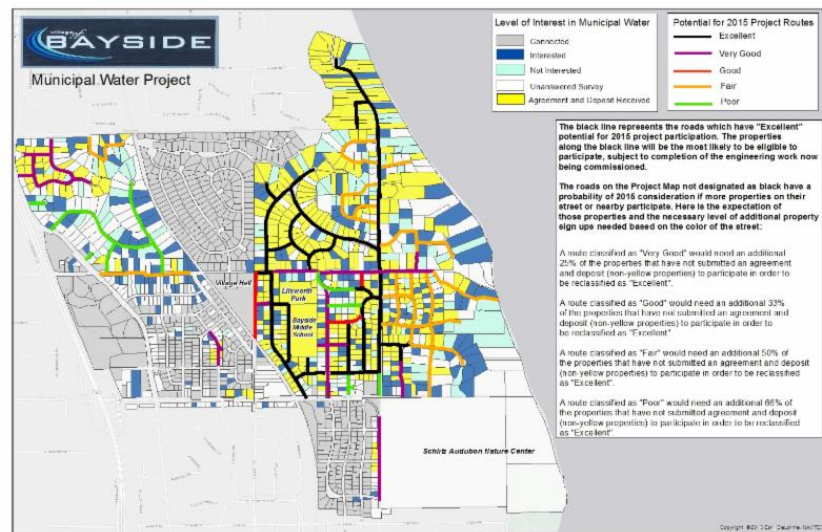




Based on the agreements and deposits received by the [Bayside Municipal Water Project Association #1, U.A.](#), a 5-tier scale of potential for a 2015 project has been created and is displayed on the [municipal water project map](#).

The properties along the black line will be most likely to be eligible to participate, subject to completion of the engineering work now being commissioned. The roads on the project map not designated in black have a probability for 2015 consideration if more properties on their street or nearby participate.



Here is a little more info about voluntary water participation in Bayside.

- In 2013, approximately 13% of the community joined together and voluntarily connected to municipal water, bringing total properties in the Village with municipal water near 40%.
- 365 homes have completed the Bayside Municipal Water Project Association #1, U.A. document and submitted a deposit for preliminary engineering services and design.
- These homes, combined with homes already connected comprise over 60% of the Village that is connected or has placed a deposit to potentially connect to municipal water in 2015.
- An additional 200 homes have indicated interest in the voluntary municipal water project, but have not completed the the Association documents or submitted a deposit yet.
- Total current connections, Association sign-ups, and interested survey respondents represent 72% of the community. 21% have yet to respond, and 7% are not interested.

Streets that fall into each category are listed below, along with the additional percentage of participation necessary in order to be considered to have "Excellent" potential for a 2015 project.

Very Good (Purple):

These streets would need an additional 25% of non-yellow properties to submit an agreement and deposit in order to be reclassified as "Excellent".

Good (Red):

These streets would need an additional 33% of non-yellow properties to submit an agreement and deposit in order to be reclassified as "Excellent".

- Hermitage Rd (East of Pelham, West of Fielding)
- Fielding (North of Manor Cir, South of Fairy Chasm)

Fair (Orange):

These streets would need an additional 50% of non-yellow properties to submit an agreement and deposit in order to be reclassified as "Excellent".
