



Private Property Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) Program

The Village of Bayside, in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is offering assistance with the removal of private property ash trees to counter the spread of Emerald Ash Borer. The Village estimates that 7,000 ash trees exist on private property in Bayside. To help residents with this problem, the Village will issue aid in the form of money once specific requirements and documentation have been submitted. To receive aid from the Private Property Ash Tree Removal Program you must meet these steps:



Fill out the interest form (online or at Village Hall).	Deadline: July 31, 2015
Certification of Ash trees (schedule and complete Village employee inspection of tree).	Deadline: August 15, 2015
Contract with tree removal service and provide Village with copy of contract for replacement tree order.	Deadline: August 31, 2015
Contact Village once tree is removed for certification.	Deadline: October 16, 2015
Provide proof of payment for tree removal services	Deadline, October 31, 2015

- Only Ash trees located on private property are eligible for aid.
- In order to receive aid, all necessary documentation must be provided to the Village.
- Maximum reimbursement up to 50% of removal costs, or \$200.
- All trees must be certified by the Village.
- A copy of contract and payment of the tree removal service used is required to ensure that work has been bought and paid for by the resident.
- Program is limited to 100 private property tree removals. If over 100 private property tree removals a lottery will be conducted.
- If under 100 private property tree removals, participants may submit additional Ash trees.
- Replacement trees will be provided the spring 2016

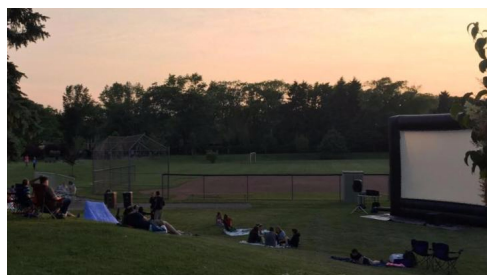
