Crack sealing work will take place on Brown Deer Road and Lake Drive between 7am and 4pm on Wednesday, September 23. During this time, please exercise patience and caution while the crews are at work.

Road Closures and Detours

This coming week, several streets in the central part of the Village will be impacted by the municipal water project.

- Pelham Parkway between Brown Deer Road and Standish will be closed.
- Pelham Parkway between Standish and Ellsworth will be limited to school bus traffic.
- Greenvale between Hermitage and Brown Deer Road will be closed.
- Fielding between Glencoe and Manor will be closed.
- Standish Place between Lake Drive and Bayside Drive will be limited.
- Hermitage between Lake Drive and Bayside Drive will be limited.
- Meadowlark between Fairy Chasm and Hermitage will be limited.



It is anticipated that:

- Port Washington Road should re-open to full traffic early next week.
- Fairy Chasm between the railroad tracks and Sleepy Hollow/Iroquois should also be open early next week.

School Bus Safety

School buses are in full operation for the start of the school year and children are out and about. Be mindful that when school buses have their red lights flashing, traffic must stop in both directions no less than 20 feet from the bus. In addition, vehicles must yield to pedestrians already in the crosswalk. Cyclists are also considered traffic and must obey all traffic laws.
