Clean out your Culvert

As you clean up leaves from your lawn for our leaf collection next week, don't forget to look in your driveway culvert. Your driveway culvert is the stormwater pipe running under the bottom of your driveway.

This pipe is critical to allowing stormwater to flow properly through the Village. With recent rains, many leaves have clogged these pipes causing yards or roads to flood. Please check your culvert and make sure all leaves are removed from the openings.



Don't over stuff

This time of year, there is a lot of excess garbage and recycling. Please make sure the material in your bins is not overly packed down, boxes are broken down, and the lids will close. Materials outside of the bin are not collected with our regular collections. We use automated equipment to allow us to reach every home in the Village.

Plans for 2016

On November 19, the Village Board adopted the [2016 Bayside Budget](#). This budget is not just numbers, it is the operations plan for the Village for 2016 and establishes goals and priorities. The Village remains committed to the four strategic values of fiscal integrity, civic engagement, service excellence, and sustainability.

The cost of operating the Village government in 2016 has increased slightly from 2015. The 2016 overall proposed tax levy is an increase of .802% over 2015. This increase in the 2016 budget will cover:

- Resurfacing Village streets
- Continued implementation of the Emerald Ash Borer Management plan,
- Sewer mainline televising and culvert replacements
- Police equipment
- Replacement of a village snow plow and dump truck

The tax mill rate has decreased from 2016 from \$7.47 to \$7.41. It is important to note that of each tax dollar collected from your tax bill, approximately 25 cents remains with the Village. The remaining 75 cents is distributed according to the other taxing jurisdictions.
