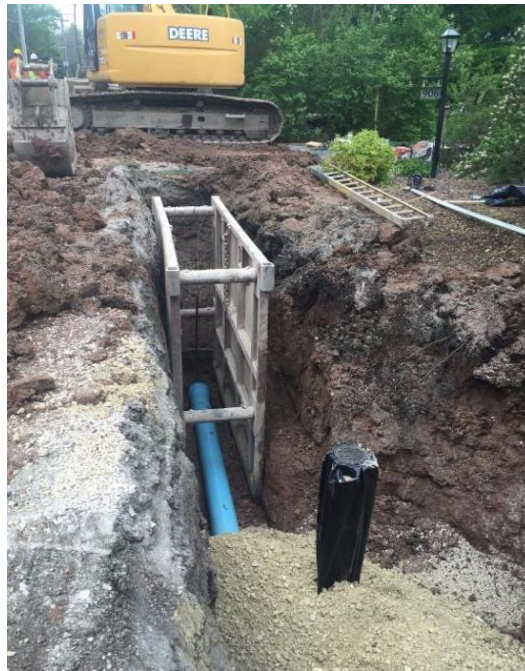

Tuesday Talk

Water main installation is complete. Here's what has been accomplished:



53,250 feet or **10** miles of water main were installed



106 hydrants were installed



558 homes, **79%** of potential homes in the project area chose to connect to water

Reminders:

- Now that water installation work is completed, all homeowners in the project should be working with their private plumbers to convert to municipal water.
- If you are keeping your well, you will need to complete the [well operation permit](#). If you are abandoning your well, your plumber should pull a permit for [well abandonment](#).
- Contact your homeowners insurance company to inform them of the new hydrants placed in the area.

Restoration Work:

- The water contractor will now be working solely on restoration.
- The first goal is to restore ditches that have not had any restoration work done to date.
- The water contractor will continue through their list of items as the weather allows. They will be back next spring/summer to fix any outstanding issues.
