Selling your home? Looking to buy a home in Bayside? Make sure the home is on the [compliance list](#).

The certificate of compliance certifies that the home has been inspected by our contracted building inspector to meet code requirements. This helps maintain the health, safety and welfare of the community and housing stock.

There have been modifications made to the program, so it's easier to get your home on the certified list:

Option #1: The all-inclusive package - \$175 - Initial inspection, follow-up inspection, and up to two follow-up inspections if needed. All additional inspections would be billed at the hourly rate of \$50, one-hour minimum.

Option #2: The two-for - \$140 - Initial inspection and one follow-up inspection. All additional inspections would be billed at the hourly rate of \$50, one-hour minimum.

Option #3: Just the basic - \$100 - Initial inspection. Any follow-up or additional inspections would be billed at the hourly rate of \$50, one-hour minimum.

Homes that have received the certificate within the last year are [posted on our website](#). Copies of the certificate and report are also placed in the property file which the public can view at Village Hall.
