1. [Order Mulch](#). The Village has a ground mulch product available for \$90 per 5 yards. We deliver it right to your home. 10% off through April 25.

2. [Get your rain barrel](#). Only 10 left. The Village has rain barrels for sale for \$45 each or 3 for \$125. We can also deliver these right to your home.

Garbage/Recycling Containers

Did you know?

- You can [rent extra bins](#) if you know you are having a party or gathering. It's \$25 per week for the first container and \$5 for each additional container. The cans are then picked up with your next collection.
- You can [request a call back](#) for \$36 if you forget to put out your garbage/recycling or need your can emptied again before the next regular collection.
- Starting in April, we will have 2 times per month where you can bring excess
