- Increased property values

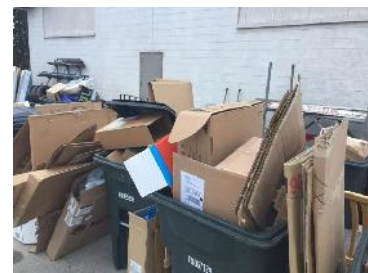

We are donating:

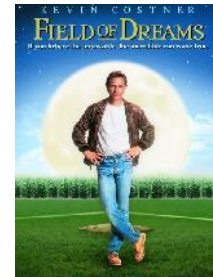
- 4 large containers of food donations
