Tips to Make [Fall Clean-Up](#) a Great Event for Everyone

1. **Have your donation ready.** To participate, three non-perishable food items or a monetary donation for Hunger Task Force will be collected.

2. **Have your items separated and organized in your car.** Following are the disposal categories:

- **Yard Waste** - branches, shrubs, etc. As you enter, notify the staff of yard waste
- **Electronics** - anything with a battery or cord; does not need to be in working condition (No TVs)
- **Steel** - anything metal such as clothes hangers, grills, lawnmowers, chairs, etc.
- **Batteries | Light Bulbs | ink cartridges | Eye Glasses**
- **Recycling** - cardboard, plastic, etc.
- **Mattresses and Box Springs**
- **Bikes**
- **Habitat for Humanity** - furniture, home improvement items, etc. that are still in good condition
- **Goodwill** - clothes, shoes, books, household items, etc. in good condition
- **Garbage** - only items that DO NOT MATCH any other category go in garbage
- **Paper Shredding** - as you exit, paper shredding is in the Village Hall parking lot. All paper clips/binder clips must be previously removed

Items Not Accepted: TVs, Paint, Household Hazardous Waste, Tires

3. **Follow instructions for where to park/stop your vehicle.** We want to keep the event as safe as possible for everyone involved.

4. **Help.** If able, please be prepared to help unload your vehicle.

5. **Have Patience.** Staff will work as quickly as possible to get you through, but please expect long lines at times.
