Winter(?) Weather

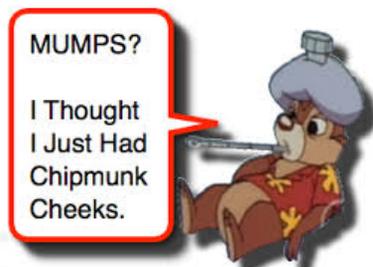
The weather lately has been unpredictable to say the least, which has led to hazardous driving conditions.

Mumps on the Rise



There was an increase in mumps cases in 2016. Mumps is an acute viral illness and is spread through the air or by direct contact with saliva or infected droplets. Symptoms usually appear 12 - 25 days after exposure and cause inflamed, swollen and tender salivary glands. Other symptoms may include fever, fatigue, weakness, cough, or pain with chewing or swallowing. Some mumps' patients may even be asymptomatic.

Vaccination is the best way to protect against mumps . This vaccine is a combination of measles-mumps-rubella (MMR).
