## Indian Creek Watershed Diversion Project

The Indian Creek Watershed Diversion (ICWD) Project is a stormwater



improvement to increase stormwater management capacity for large storm events, such as last Monday's.

As part of ICWD, stormwater from Ellsworth Park will be diverted to Village Hall and outlet to Lake Michigan as opposed to going to the stormwater pond at 621 Brown Deer Road and entering Indian Creek.

The project is expected to begin in late July and complete in late fall. Stay tuned to the Buzz for updates as this project may impact traffic patterns.

- The [Police Department](#) encourages residents to report safety concerns.

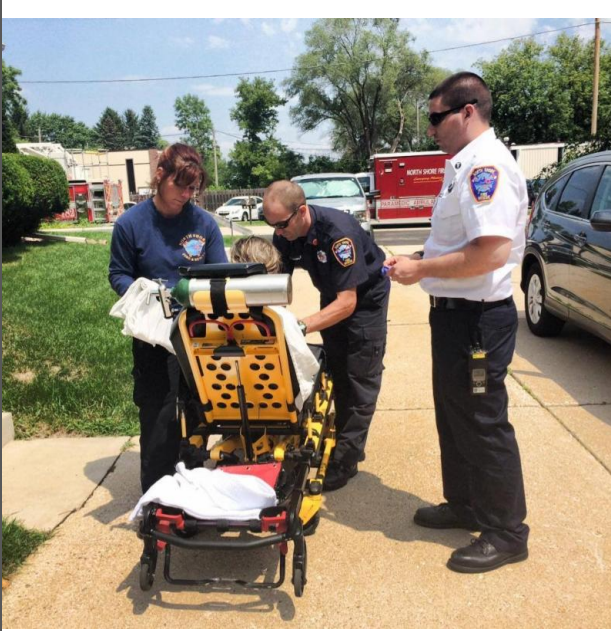

### New Fence Code

[Municipal Code](#) was recently updated to simplify the interpretation and application of the fence code.

The code now provides for 15% of the perimeter to be solid fence with the rest of the allowable fence to be at least 25% open.



## Do You Have PulsePoint?

[PulsePoint](#) is a mobile app that sends you the same alerts as emergency medical personnel when someone nearby is in need of CPR. The goal is to get the victim CPR as soon as possible.

The [North Shore Fire/Rescue Department](#) wants to increase the number of bystanders who perform CPR and apply an automatic external defibrillator (AED).
