Stormwater Ditch Construction

As a conclusion to the Village's [stormwater grant project](#), three (3) prototype ditch designs will be constructed on N King Road. Construction is scheduled to begin on August 27 and conclude in early to mid-September.

The bioswale, rain garden, and bio-retention features will be on display for all Village residents as potential solutions for challenging drainage ditch situations.

- Break down cardboard boxes.

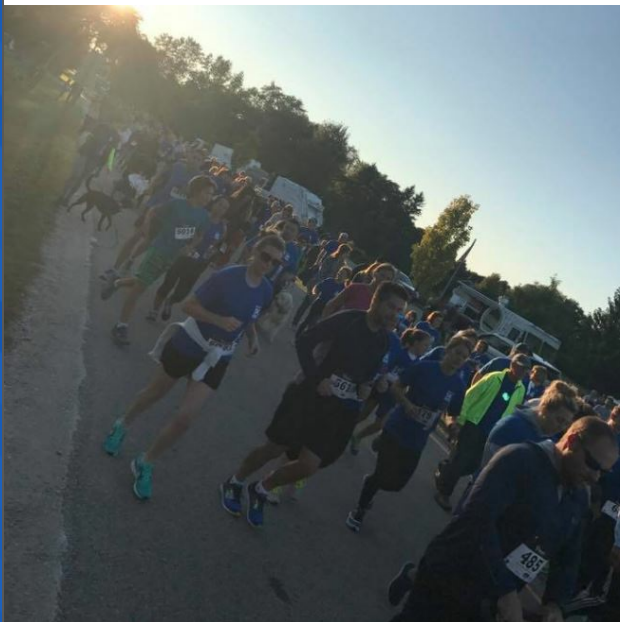


- Leave three (3) feet of space between container and other objects.
