- Monday, October 22: Until 6:00pm
- Thursday, November 1: Until 5:00pm
- Friday, November 2: Until 5:00pm

No absentee voting may occur the day before the election, Monday, November 5, per state statute.

## SIDS Awareness Month

October is [Sudden Infant Death Syndrome \(SIDS\)](#) Awareness Month. SIDS is the unexplained death of a baby under one year of age without a known cause.

To reduce the risk of SIDS:

- Place baby on back for sleep
- Use a firm surface covered only by a fitted sheet
- Do not share a bed with a baby
- Keep soft objects away from the sleep area
- Do not smoke around a baby
