As a result, the Village continues to give serious consideration to those concerns and has cancelled its next meeting scheduled for October 4th. No future meetings to discuss a proposed TID have been scheduled at this time.

Should the CDA schedule another meeting to continue to study the development of the quadrant bordered by Port Washington, Brown Deer Road, I-43 and White Oak Lane, we will be sure to notify residents via the Village meeting calendar and web site as well as provide a weekly update in the Bayside Buzz.
