Tree Cutting Project

The Village will remove the worst rated trees in the public right-of-way as identified by a certified arborist over the next couple of months.

Letters will be mailed to impacted homeowners and trees marked with yellow ribbon. Ash trees impacted by the [Emerald Ash Borer](#) will be the focus of the tree removal project as well as trees in significantly-deteriorated condition.

Forestry

Handles facing towards residence.
No overhead obstructions.

3-FOOT RULE

Keep carts at least **three feet away** from other carts, mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, and utility poles so trucks can easily access the cart.

Keep Clear

To improve the garbage and recycling collection experience, please follow these guidelines:

- Keep cans three (3) feet from all other objects.
- Do not put items next to or on top of the can for collection.
- Place cans at the edge of the road with lids facing the road.
- Break down cardboard boxes.
- Be sure items are out by 7am on collection days.
