

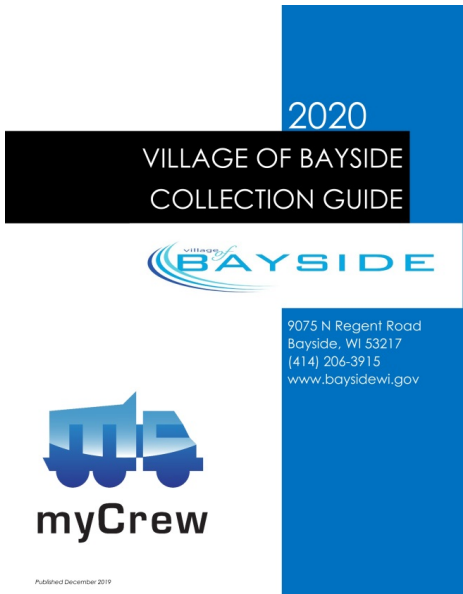


Guests need parking?
